Opportunities at EAC!



Every now and then some wonderful opportunity presents itself to make a big difference. Such an opportunity has arisen! EAC can become part of the whole art scene in the region! The Gallery at the Airport (GATA) has lost its funding from the City of Eugene. Rather than lose this important venue, which provides the introduction to travelers of the culture in the whole area, four art organizations have partnered and have agreed to each have an art exhibit for three months, on a rotating basis. Jordan Schnitzer Museum of Art has agreed to take the first exhibit scheduled for July, August, September 2009.



Each of the other partners (EAC, LCC, DIVA) will have a 3 month segment. The time frames will be determined by the GATA Board which consists of one representative from each organization. Dottie Chase will represent EAC and Cheryl Leontina will fill in when needed.

Each Partner will present two proposals to the GATA committee, they will in turn choose one that will fit the plan for the year's exhibits, making sure there is a variety.

An Art Selection committee has been formed at EAC. This committee will select art from our membership (*another reason to become a member of EAC*). The criteria of the GATA committee is that the art be of the "highest quality representing our organization." This can be a very challenging and a daunting task for the selection committee. There will be many questions as to why this or that piece was not chosen, there could be many answers, some of which may be: "not appropriate for the theme of the show" or "not properly framed," etc..

The advantage to being a part of this big picture is that it gives EAC exposure it would not otherwise be afforded.

Emerald Art Center will be represented along with other important organizations in the area.

This collaboration will promote tourism in Springfield, identify EAC with the whole community, and in turn, will look good on our grant information.
