## Colleen Howe

*"How to Structure a Successful Painting"*  
A 3-Day Pastel Workshop - All Skill Levels  
**June 17-19, 2010, 9am-4pm**

Colleen K. Howe grew up in southwestern Montana on a 1,000 acre cattle ranch. She had many adventures on her "paint" horse, Pinky, exploring the meadows and river places near her home.

Colleen continued her interest in landscape painting at Brigham Young University and the University of Utah. She later began to specialize in pastel painting with Sally Strand, Doug Dawson, and Michael Workman.

Colleen is now a nationally known, award-winning pastel artist and is a signature member of the Pastel Society of America and American Women Artists. Her plein air painting workshops have been conducted across the United States with an annual 10-day workshop to Provence, France. Articles about her work have appeared in *The Pastel Journal*, *The Artist's Magazine* and *Southwest Art*.

Students will spend the first day of this workshop indoors, studying value and composition and how to translate that into color using pastel techniques. Colleen will demonstrate how to under-paint using watercolor, acrylic or oil. The next two days will be spent outdoors, weather permitting.
