## Erin Paroubek

### “Color Mixing & Layering Techniques Using Acrylics”

*Class for Adults & Teens 16 and older*

**Saturdays, February 20 & 27, 2010**

This is a class designed for beginning painters. We will begin by examining the properties of colors so you can learn to predict the outcomes of the mixtures you create on your palettes. Using what we’ve learned, we will use a variety of brushes and painting knives to explore various layering and mark-making techniques. Acrylics are fast drying, so we will have the benefit of working through many layers and experimenting with multiple painting tools in only a short period of time. The techniques you learn here will allow you to form rich, layered paintings. And the concepts and techniques translate well to oil paints. What you take home may be an abstract, completed painting, or perhaps a base layer to which you can add information at a later time.

**Materials:**

- Acrylic paint colors (feel free to choose additional colors): titanium white, cadmium red medium, alizarin crimson, cadmium yellow medium, lemon yellow, sap green, phthalo green, van dyke brown, ultramarine blue, prussian blue, cerulean blue, black (lamp, mars, or ivory) 37ml tubes for all colors except white, which you will want in larger 75-200ml tubes
- Brushes: at least 5, different sizes (4-12) and types (filbert, flat, bright, round)
- Palette: This is easy to make with a sheet of plastic or glass duct-taped around the edges and supported underneath with a white surface (white mat board works well).
- Painting knives/palette knife: Get several painting knives of various sizes and shapes for experimenting with different techniques. The palette knife is for mixing paint, but a painting knife can be substituted as long as its blade is long and wide enough.
- Pad of Canvas Paper
